Dear Friends,

I was reminded again yesterday how very easily our lives can turn from the peaceful calm of a lagoon like tranquillity to a storm, as of course some of the disciples of Jesus well knew being professional fishermen on the Sea of Galilee. My God is my Rock, in whom I take Refuge.

A place I love to visit, and have spent many a week over recent years, is the Island of

Lindisfarne off the North East coast of England, I have been there through storms and howling gales and ate ice cream sat on the bench overlooking the harbour with azure skies and mill pond like sea state. It can all change so very quickly, it can whip your ice cream off your cone and your vinegar off your chips in a snap of Mary Poppins' fingers!

When you pass over the modern causeway onto the Island you will pass by 'the refuge box', a place on stilts, higher than the highest tide, the place to seek if you are stranded by the changing fast pace of the incoming sea and your own foolishness it can and has ended in tragedy for some.

Life, like the sea state can change rapidly and leave us bewildered and threatened, the phone call, the letter, the email and life changes direction and our focus alters entirely, what then, where do we turn, to whom do we go? Perhaps as you read this you are finding your life's focus is changing, and you are seeking to come to terms with a new reality?



In preparing this article I felt strongly that it would be timely for some of you, that your life events have taken a turn and you are going through a time of stress and worry, both unexpected and unwelcome.

If I may point your hearts to Psalm 61:1-4 and Psalm 27:5 where the Psalmist directs his prayer to God in a time of trouble, he is our refuge a place to find shelter amidst the storm, 40 times in the Psalms we find the word 'refuge' its root meaning carries the thought of 'impregnable safety' a place inaccessible to an enemy.

Sometimes life can be 'Raging', may we all find that place of refuge in God, '...let the morning bring me word of your unfailing love' the Psalmist tells us in Psalm 143...may your day dawn trusting in the God of refuge.
