John Everett Millais "The Martyr of the Solway" (1871) Walker Art Gallery

When I first saw this painting by Millais, in Liverpool a few years ago, I immediately did a little research about the Solway Martyrs. Who were they?

Margaret Wilson was a young Scottish Covenanter from Wigtown in Scotland. She and Margaret McLachlan were executed by drowning in the Solway in May 1685.

The Covenanters refused to accept King James as head of the Church and his right to appoint bishops. They held out for Congregationalism

and the ability for churches to remain independent of State control. Despite there having been a reprieve issued, the execution of the two women still went ahead.

Wikipedia tells us, "It is said that, as the tide rose, she defiantly quoted from the Psalms and the Epistles, and sang until she drowned..."

As I looked at Margaret Wilson, I began to wonder:

- How far would I be prepared to go for my beliefs?
- How many people are still being martyred today for their faith?
- Would I be prepared to die simply for the right to deny the Church of England the ability to tell non-conformists how to govern and organize the way that we do church?




We are really pleased that we have recently been granted a silver award and are grateful to Gill Williams for her work on completing this on our behalf.

### We are currently looking for


- Property Steward we have a brilliant Property Team, but are in need of someone to head it speak to Rev. Tim if you'd like to know more
