Risk and Renewal

We are now well into the second week of Lent.

Lent, of course, is the 6-week journey we take leading to Holy week, where Jesus is taken and crucified, and then on to Easter Sunday and the joy of resurrection.

During Lent our lectionary readings lead us to consider some of the stories of Jesus life, and then the events of the Passion.

These include the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness; Jesus meeting a Samaritan woman at a well and asking for water; the visit of Nicodemus at night for fear of being spotted; the healing of a blind man on the sabbath; the raising of Lazarus from the dead; and the betrayal, trial and crucifixion of Jesus.

All these stories include elements of risk. Risk, of course, for Jesus and His disciples, but also risk for Nicodemus, Lazarus, and many others.

They also include stories of Renewal - atonement. People are reconciled to God and one another, made whole, given life.

Risk and Renewal. Isn't that what Jesus was doing by going to the cross – risking His life to reconcile us to God – to renew our relationship and give us life?

But it also makes me think – and maybe it should make us all think during Lent – about our own response to both Risk and Renewal.

What about Renewal in our own lives? Who do I need to make whole? Who do I need to reconcile myself to? Who can I bring atonement to? What should I do that I have not yet done to bring restoration?

And what about Risk? Am I prepared to take the risk to make things right? Does my self-preservation trump my sense of courage to act for justice and healing for others? Will I be prepared to step out of my comfort-zone and make a difference?



Maybe it's not just the disciples who desert Jesus, or betray Jesus? Maybe we can too? Who, or what, do I need to stand up for - to stay and not run? To act and not sleep? Who should I risk defending in order to bring wholeness and renewal to their life?

Being a follower of Jesus is risky. It is uncomfortable. But being a follower of Jesus means enabling life and renewal - not just for us, but for everyone!
