What's believed to be the most famous tag-line of this generation is the Nike slogan 'Just do it'.

It's been going 35 years now! The phrase was created by Dan Wieden, co-founder of advertising agency Wieden + Kennedy who were working for Nike, and its source is quite macabre. Apparently, these were more or less the last words of a death-row inmate as he faced the firing squad. Wieden saw it on TV, sold it as a slogan to Nike, and the rest is history.

Since then, it's become synonymous with the Nike brand, and the most used, copied and quoted meme or catch-phrase in the world.

The phrase, however, is a pretty good motto for us as Christians, and followers of Jesus. We often talk and think about what we call 'orthodoxy' – having the right beliefs, but we don't hear so much about what's called orthopraxy – doing the right actions. 'Just do it' would be a good motto for us to take on board.

I believe that faith is a verb, not a noun. It's a *doing* word. You see, what we believe won't make a jot of difference to other people. But what we do just might.

The apostle James said this in James 2:14-17: 'What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone claims to have faith but has no deeds? Can such faith save them? Suppose a brother or a sister is without clothes and daily food. If one of you says to them, "Go in peace; keep warm and well fed," but does nothing about their physical needs, what good is it? In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead'. He goes on to say 'Be doers of the word, not just hearers'.

One of the earliest accounts of St. Francis, quotes Francis as telling the first friars, "You only know as much as you *do*." His emphasis on action, practice, and lifestyle was foundational and revolutionary for its time, and is at the root of

Franciscan spirituality. He is reported to have once said: 'Preach the gospel at all times. Use words if necessary'.

We are all busy people, and today's culture is telling us we need to take time for ourselves, and rest, and look after ourselves. Fair enough. But there is also a world out there – even in the streets where you live - even in the church where you worship – that needs people of service and action; people willing to get stuck in and make a difference; people who will 'just do it'. Will you be one of them?








#### **Committal Service**

#### **All About Anna Chaplaincy**

#### Why Anna?

In Luke chapter 2 we read about Anna, a faithful older person who recognizes the baby Jesus as the Messiah and tells everyone about him. Older people still have so much to offer in wisdom and life lessons. They should not be forgotten or overlooked because of age.



#### What is Anna Chaplaincy?

An Anna Chaplain is someone who accompanies older people at this stage in their life and promotes their spiritual welfare. It is a ministry focused on visiting older people wherever they may be living, whether in residential and nursing homes, sheltered housing, retirement complexes or other private homes. The emphasis is on spiritual support, but practical help can also be offered.

An Anna Chaplain also has a wider role as an advocate and champion of the contribution older people make to society. Spiritual support can enable older people to live more peacefully in their later years and be prepared to face the end of their earthly life.\*

#### Why are you telling me this?

I feel called to this role and having completed the training, am being commissioned as an Anna Chaplain on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at Cottage Wood at 5pm. Everyone is welcome.
