

# Penrith Methodist Circuit Weekly Bulletin Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2023

### By Faith

I wonder how often you think about your faith journey in a wider context than just here and now? Many of us will remember, with thankfulness, those who made specific, lasting imprints on our lives, by deepening our understanding of what it means to follow Jesus as we journeyed together for a time.

But what about people we may never have known, but were instrumental in, shaping those who shaped us? Individuals whose commitment to prayer and their desire to be Kingdom builders, may have cost them dearly because they pursued a vision beyond their 'here and now'. Perhaps such people have a keener sense of their own lives, being part of an ancient story where theirs unfolds in the context of God's eternal narrative. Hebrews -11- people, if you like.

The author of Hebrews quotes the psalms, Genesis, Exodus, Jeremiah (to name a few) many times: the past is recalled that it might influence the present. In chapter 11 there is a wonderful summary of the story of Israel. It is presented, not as a sterile list of events, but as a narrative of individuals who lived, acted, and died 'by faith'. The author's intention is made clear with a 'therefore' at the start of chapter 12:



Therefore, since we also have such a large cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us lay aside every hindrance and the sin that so easily ensnares us. Let us run with endurance the race that lies before us, keeping our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith. For the joy that lay before him, he endured the cross, despising the shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

The reason that we are part of a Christian community today is because each generation since the early church has had people committed to living by faith, believing their stories simply follow on from Hebrews 11.



### **All About Anna Chaplaincy**

### Why Anna?

In Luke chapter 2 we read about Anna, a faithful older person who recognizes the baby Jesus as the Messiah and tells everyone about him. Older people still have so much to offer in wisdom and life lessons. They should not be forgotten or overlooked because of age.

### What is Anna Chaplaincy?

An Anna Chaplain is someone who accompanies older people at this stage in their life and promotes their spiritual welfare. It is a ministry focused on visiting older people wherever they may be living, whether in residential and nursing homes, sheltered housing, retirement complexes or other private homes. The emphasis is on spiritual support, but practical help can also be offered.

An Anna Chaplain also has a wider role as an advocate and champion of the contribution older people make to society. Spiritual support can enable older people to live more peacefully in their later years and be prepared to face the end of their earthly life.\*
