#### **Happy Holidays!**



Last week, the schools all finished for the summer holidays. Whether you've children in your life or not, July and August are popular times to take a week or two's break somewhere. There are less 'meetings' (always a good thing!), and many of our clubs and activities are put on hold until September. Hopefully, the weather will be warm and sunny, and many of you will be planning to get away on vacation and relax!

You may remember from a devotion by Lois in this bulletin in May, that the word 'holiday' has a Christian origin. The word was derived from the Old English 'hāligdæg', from hālig (holy) + dæg (day)." Literally speaking, a "holiday" is a "holy day."

Historically this referred to specific holy days in the Christian liturgical calendar – especially Christmas, Easter, and Whitsun. On such holy days, people would often mix worship with social gatherings and activities. Others would embark on pilgrimages to visit holy sites.

Before Christianity, Judaism followed a similar pattern. For each Jewish religious festival, people would travel to Jerusalem to worship at the temple and join in the festivities. The Psalms are full of songs that were sung as people travelled. Psalm 122 begins: 'I was very glad when they said to me, "Let us go up to the house of the Lord." Jerusalem, our feet are standing inside your gates'.

So 'holidays' were 'holy days', when people sought a special encounter with God.

I wonder if you ever think about your holidays as holy days? Because, in many ways, they should be, and can be.

You see, as we start to unwind, and be still, and relax, and leave 'work' behind, there is always something sacred waiting to be discovered. As you rest, you become open to the God who wants to surprise you with His glory and restore you in spirit and soul – as well as physically.

So, as you take your holidays this year, may you also know them as holy days. Days when you meet God, encounter more of God's love, and know God's presence with you - giving healing, and restoration.

I'll leave you with a quote from the French Jesuit Priest Teilhard de Chardin: 'We have only to go a little beyond the frontier of sensible appearances in order to see the divine welling up and showing through... by means of all created things, without exception, the divine assails us, penetrates us and moulds us. We imagine it as distant and inaccessible, whereas in fact we live steeped in its burning layers'.

May that be your experience. God waits to be discovered! Happy holy days!


The majority will be emailed however, some will be left on a table in reception to be collected.
