An Historic Moment

1st September, 2023, is a truly historic moment. It is the date of the birth of a new Methodist Circuit, as the East Cumbria Methodist Circuit comes into being. And, you can say that you not only were there to witness its arrival, but actively took part to celebrate its inauguration.

To celebrate the event, this Sunday we will be inviting everyone from across the newly formed Circuit to come together to worship and praise God, as well as committing ourselves to work together in mission. Please don't miss out! There are more details to be found in the Pastoral Letter sent out by Tim and I a couple of weeks ago, and in notices in this Bulletin.

A Circuit exists as a group of Churches and congregations in a particular geographical area, who are committed to working together in mission. The Circuit plans and organises the resources across the area to better equip and enable those Churches for God's mission in their own patch. How can we support and encourage one another to spread the good news of God's love in the towns and villages of East Cumbria?



The Circuit covers geographically quite a large area, from Patterdale in the west, to Alston in the east. Google Maps tells me that this is a distance of 33 miles, and (in current driving conditions as I write) would take me just under an hour to drive. How, then, can we sustain a unified Circuit identity over such an area? How do we know what is happening right across this new Circuit, in order to support and encourage one another?

Well... that is where this very Bulletin can help! Please encourage everyone you know in your own congregation to read this Circuit Bulletin each week. This way, we can become aware of (and support) events that are happening elsewhere around the area.



And please make sure that you send into the office news about the things that are happening where you are. Let's share good news stories of events around the Circuit. There is so much that is happening, from concerts and recitals at St. Patrick's in Patterdale, to a new Alpha Course running at The Chat Room in Alston. Spread the word!


