Thank You For the Music

The title above is taken from the well known song by ABBA. The words explain that someone who is a 'nobody' is transformed by singing and music and as such gives thanks for these gifts. Does this resonate with you? You might not feel you can sing very well (I now have trouble with any note higher than middle C!) but you can appreciate music provided by others and can join with all in the congregation to sing God's Praise.

Do you watch 'Songs of Praise' on Sunday? When we lived in Sheffield there was a recording of 'Songs of Praise' from Meadowhall, a very large shopping mall. People gathered from many different churches and it involved a rehearsal one day and the actual recording on the following night. At the rehearsal we were guided how to sing the hymns and told to smile! Each piece was sung several times so that the sound engineers and camera crew could choose the best sounds and pictures. When we met again the following night for the recording again each hymn was sung more than once.

When we watch the programme on TV, all we notice is the singers, musicians and conductor but don't think of all the background folk. If the producer, engineers and camera people did not play their part there would be no programme. Similarly, do we sometimes take God's silent work behind the scenes for granted and just accept things are there by right?

God is constantly caring, even in places where hope seems lost. Often His work is carried out by people – those who bring help and comfort, food and medicine. When it seems that all is lost still God is faithful and sorrows with His creation.



Let us always remember that He is in control and also give our thanks to those who reflect His love and care in all they do. Whoever is singing and wherever the hymns/songs come from, let them be a reminder that God is always reaching out with His love to us.

As Psalm 96 v1 tells us 'Sing a new song to the Lord'.


