'USEFUL AND BEAUTIFUL' ECCL 3:11

Dear Friends,

Have you noticed the many programmes springing up on the TV over recent months concerning restoration?

It could be houses, gardens, motorcycles, domestic items, furniture, or electrical goods from the 1930's. There is for many a real pleasure in seeing things restored to good working and useful order. Perhaps you have 'had a go' at restoring something recently. I wonder how it turned out for you? I found recently a very interesting article concerning the Japanese art of 'Kintsugi'.

'As a philosophy, *kintsugi* is similar to the Japanese philosophy of Wabi-Sabi, an embracing of the flawed or imperfect, as Japanese aesthetics value marks of wear from the use of an object. This can be seen as a rationale for keeping an object around even after it has broken; it can also be understood as a justification of *kintsugi* itself, highlighting cracks and repairs as events in the life of an object, rather than allowing its service to end at the time of its damage or breakage'.

There is no attempt to hide the damage, the damage itself is literally illuminated...

'It's a centuries-old Japanese art. Practitioners put the broken pieces together with a special tree sap lacquer that is dusted with gold, silver, or platinum, creating unique and beautiful new pieces out of what was once broken. In Kintsugi, the cracks still show. In fact, they are meant to show. This really struck me, because I know whenever I have repaired something in the past, my goal has always been to make the cracks invisible'.
