'Come, Lord Jesus'

We begin Advent this Sunday, and in Advent, Christians often say the mantra, "Come, Lord Jesus".

It comes from Revelation 22:20, where it says: 'Surely I am coming soon.' Amen. Come, Lord Jesus!"

But what do we mean when we say this in Advent?

It refers, of course, to the hope we have that Christ not only came, at Christmas, but will come again, and restore all of creation to the way God originally intended.

But the phrase also holds a powerful message for us about living in hope right now, in all the emptiness and non-fulfilment of our lives. It means recognising that the 'perfect' is yet to come, and we don't need everything to be perfect right now.

This Advent season of hopeful waiting – knowing that Jesus did come - keeps our lives open to grace and a future shaped by God rather than us.



Demanding immediate satisfaction or insisting that life meets our expectations, prevents us from truly saying, "Come, Lord Jesus." Instead, Advent invites us to hold out for the full picture that God continues to unfold in our world and in us.

'Come Lord Jesus' goes beyond a vague feeling that everything will work out. It's a conviction that God is overcoming the brokenness of this world – and whatever brokenness there is in our lives.

It's a leap into both the freedom and surrender of hope - a patient and trustful willingness to live without complete closure, finding contentment at a deeper level, knowing our satisfaction comes from a source beyond ourselves.



Just as Christ has come to us in the past, Christ will come again. "Come, Lord Jesus" becomes a declaration not of desperation, but of confidence that the story of Christ's transformative love continues.

So, this Advent, let us all pray for ourselves and for our world – Come, Lord Jesus!








# **Carol Singing with the Town Band**

These will be taken to an orphanage and refugee centre in UKRAINE where they will be made into TRENCH CANDLES, which are used for light, heat and even cooking.




