The very basis and foundations of many people's lives are being shaken, so much is unstable and rocking, whether its employment, careers, housing, food,

energy, family values or the future itself, so much is registering on the richer scale of life...the needle is off the graph paper.

'And we have this treasure in our earthern vessels' this message of HOPE and PEACE through the living Christ Jesus, May the Holy Spirit Inspire us and give us openings to 'PRESENT JESUS' this advent season and on into the New Year 'this is NOT a drill' this is the real thing, what an opportunity to reveal God's grace to a troubled world.

We have been really encouraged by the help and support that people have given us in the lead up to this launch event, and to all of those who came on the day.


In return, we want to thank them and everyone who, in various ways, contributed to the success of our first gathering.
