## The Borders That Divide

We are in the middle of the week of prayer for Christian unity, and I find myself despairing about how little unity we truly have. More and more I see people clinging to the strict boxes we have placed ourselves in, afraid to step out and explore the unknown. At the same time, we persecute anyone who doesn't fit in that box, saying they're wrong and creating even more division. Is this what Jesus truly wanted? Are we really called to hurt other Christians, other humans, because of a different belief that we hold?

During World War I, Mark Sykes and Francois Georges-Picot drew the borders of the Middle East. The two diplomats' pencils divided the map of one of the most volatile regions in the world into states that cut through ethnic and religious communities. The effects of this can still be seen in the region today. It resulted in displacement, violence, arguments over territory. When we draw borders around our faith, we not only restrict what God can do in our lives, we risk being hostile to those who don't fall within those boundaries.

Father Richard Rohr says this "Unfortunately, the notion of faith that emerged in the West was much more a rational assent to the truth of certain mental beliefs rather than a calm and hopeful trust that God is inherent in all things, and this whole thing is going somewhere good."

This idea that *we know what is right and you don't* has hurt so many people. I know too many who are feeling hurt or wounded because of the rejection they were shown by a strict and rigid system that refused to accept them. Let me tell you this is not what Jesus wanted.

We all know the story of the good Samaritan: a man is beaten up and left to die by robbers. Walking past the man was a Levite and a Priest, both of whom refused to help him. It was the Samaritan that finally helped this man find true healing. We often depict the church as the good Samaritan, helping those less fortunate than ourselves, but I'm worried that the church has turned into the



other people in the story, the Priest, the Levite, yes even the robbers! We are ignoring the hurt because they don't fit into our comfortable boxes whilst Jesus is calling us to be the Samaritan. The one who helps people find true healing.

So, I pray that we can start to look past the borders that divide us and begin to accept people for the wonderful children of God that they are.

Thank you to everyone who has given candles. Please keep collecting them. Trench candles are urgently needed.


The soldiers also need (in good condition) socks, woolly hats and gloves. AND (NEW) toothbrushes, toothpaste and razors.

I'm struggling to find someone who will be so kind to become a sponsor for my sister and her son. They are tidy and nice people, you will be able to like them. At this time it's very important. I have to save my nephew. He is just a boy. His life has just begun. My sister's name is Yulia Makarenko and is 47. My nephew is Pavel Makarenko, who is 17.

I'm begging you and ask you, your friends and people you know, if they can help and host them so they can get visas to come to the UK. We are so grateful for the support of people in the church.

#### **Cleaner Wanted**


Skelton Methodist Church are looking for a cleaner.




