

# Weekly Bulletin Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2024

## You're NOT the only one!

We're here because the Post Office told every single one of us sat here today, told us over and over, "You're the only one."

Those are words from the recent *Mr Bates vs the Post Office* drama series on ITV. It's horrendous, isn't it, that this wasn't a work of fiction, but a true story. Hundreds of sub-postmasters were – and still are – caught up in what many are saying is the biggest miscarriage of justice in British legal history, with terrible emotional, physical, and mental loss to people's lives.

A faulty computer system led to so many Post Office proprietors having wrong convictions of theft and fraud, imprisonment, and bankruptcy. It led to mental and physical illness, broken marriages – and more. I know personal stories of people trying to balance the books of their Post Offices by putting in their own money.

And each of these people were told over and over again that they were the only ones. But they were not the only ones. And the injustice for these Post Office owners is not the only injustice in our towns, country – in our world.

Our news is now filled each day with outcry against the Post Office injustice – and quite right too. We all – individually and collectively – cry out for justice. We want to live in a society where justice is done.

As Christians, we are called to stand up against injustice. To not only feel aggrieved by it, but to be God's agents of making a stand against where we see injustice in our own communities.



Micah 6:8 says: 'And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God'. Amos 5:15 says: 'Hate evil, love good; maintain justice'. And Isaiah 1:17 says: 'Learn to do good; seek justice, correct oppression; bring justice to the fatherless, plead the widow's cause'. Jesus himself said in his sermon on the mount: 'Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for

righteousness, for they will be filled'. Christ stands by those who suffer injustice. He doesn't look on from a distance, but as one who, at the cross, has experienced it himself.

You and I, as God's church here on this earth, are called to stand against injustice. Each of us can be a mouthpiece for justice in our workplaces, homes, or communities. In doing so, we show what God is like. And we show those facing unfairness and injustice that they're not the only ones. And they are not alone. We are there with them. God is there with them.

Trench candles are urgently needed.


The soldiers also need (in good condition) socks, woolly hats and gloves. AND (NEW) toothbrushes, toothpaste and razors.

Dear Penrith Methodist Church,

As you probably know, the situation in Ukraine is very dangerous.

I'm asking you to help my sister who lives in Kyiv. Life is getting much worse with daily drone attacks and bombs dropping near her home. I'm struggling to find someone who will be so kind to become a sponsor for my sister and her son. They are tidy and nice people, you will be able to like them. At this time it's very important. I have to save my nephew. He is just a boy. His life has just begun. My sister's name is Yulia Makarenko and is 47. My nephew is Pavel Makarenko, who is 17.

I'm begging you and ask you, your friends and people you know, if they can help and host them so they can get visas to come to the UK. We are so grateful for the support of people in the church.


