

# Weekly Bulletin Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2024



Dear Friends.

A number of years ago, myself and my two brothers in law decided we would venture out onto the Lakeland fells on a route march, camping out and climbing numerous peaks in the process. I was much younger and fitter then I might add!

I recollect, to save weight, we ate 'Vesta meals' all week. These were termed 'instant' meals, you just added boiling water to them but what that did to my digestive system I leave you to imagine...

We started out at the head of Haweswater, up the Nan Bield pass and on towards Ambleside, and obviously fish and chips. I think we ended up at the end of the week stumbling eventually into Keswick after climbing Silver How, the Langdale Pikes, Scawfell, Gable and Pillar and swimming in Langstrath beck and Derwent water, having survived swarms of midges camping overnight at Watendlath!!

When I glance at my Wainright guide books, I can recall the aching feet and memories of laughter, happiness and map reading, but I also recall the sheer weight of the packs we were carrying which were far too heavy... but we were young, naive and far too cocky for our own good. We didn't think we would experience hailstorms on Scawfell!!

The experience of hiking with a huge heavy pack has stayed with me. I did something similar when I walked Hadrian's Wall and camped out. Water is SO heavy I found. Of course, you can walk the wall now and have your personal effects carried by minibus to your next B&B along the way!!

In my 45 years of ministry, I have often come across people carrying burdens in their lives, accumulated heartaches and pain, desires for justice and sadly revenge sometimes. These are heavy burdens to bear and can crush and flatten all your peace and joy in this walk of life. In the gospel of Matthew chapter 11 **Jesus issues an invitation** to all of us who carry such burdens, He says 'Come unto Me'. He invites us to come to Him - He will give us rest when we take our yoked burdens and exchange them for His. For HIS burden IS light and we will

find rest even in our very souls. Is this what you are searching for, longing for, desperate for?

May we all, just like Pilgrim in Bunyan's 'Pilgrims Progress', lay those burdens down at His feet and find true rest, not just in our weary muscles but deep within our very souls, which only Jesus can give to us.




## Cottage Wood Centre Take Tea Out


