Into Newness

As we continue our *familiar* journey in Lent towards Easter, I wonder how many of us actually take time to be open to something *new*?

An article by the American Franciscan priest Richard Rohr challenges us to remember how radical our church fathers were: visionary, bold, and creative. And how predictable it is that church settles into a pattern which is the opposite of their message and zeal:

"constricted, change-averse, nostalgic, fearful, obsessed with boundary maintenance, turf battles, and money. Instead of greeting the world with open arms as their founders did, their successors stand guard with clenched fists. Instead of empowering others as their founders did, they hoard power. Instead of defying tradition and unleashing moral imagination as their founders did, they impose tradition and refuse to think outside the lines"

He goes on to ask two very uncomfortable questions "What happened to Christianity? What happened to Jesus and his beautiful message?"

These are indeed worthy of our time in Lenten contemplation, both personally and collectively.

Paul in his masterpiece, the letter to the Roman church, gives a powerful summary of the transformational implications of the Gospel:

"We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." Romans 6:4

So that raises another question: what should 'walking in newness of life' look like, especially as a community brought together for the purpose of glorifying our Lord?



Our attitudes are so important. Richard suggests we have two options before us: "we can approach this time [when church is in decline] as survivors, desperately

clinging to our structures and ways of being. Or, we can see ourselves as pioneers, setting out in the face of the unknown to discover new ways to live faith-filled lives. Nothing today will be the same ten years from now. Why not architect the kind of faith movement we want to see twenty-to-fifty years from now?"

The newness of Easter is needed now as much as it ever was.

Please bring donations to PMC on the day from 9am.


Small household items, washing up products, long life food and clothing appreciated. No appliances. Please bag and label. Think of what you might need when moving to a new flat with little or nothing!
