### **Sacred Wilderness**

This is the reflection I shared at last week's Woodland Collective, and I thought I would share it with you as well.

What do you think of when you hear the word wilderness?

I know in some circles 'wilderness' isn't a good thing. It is a metaphor for a hard time that we go through, often through our own doing.

To me, wilderness is a confusing mix of both enticing and intimidating. The wild is where I first experienced the presence of something sacred. It is the place that instilled a deep care for this earth on which we live. It is where I face adversity and where I build resilience. The wilderness is often the space that prepares us for something greater, and the place we return to when we need to rest and recharge. It strips away all that we use to disguise and suppress the person we truly are. The screens, the money, the presumed status. And for a lot of us that isn't easy.

There was once a refugee. A man that had been oppressed since birth. He was baptised in a river by a wild priest. When he rose from the waters he was instantly called into the wilderness where he experienced great challenges and tests of character, confirming a call upon his life. He went on to be known, in my opinion, as the greatest activist and wisest teacher the world has ever seen.

Challenging the powerful and standing with the oppressed. Jesus consistently returned to the wilderness throughout his ministry to ground himself, to rest, and to gather his strength.

So, I ask again the question we started with - what do you think when you hear the word wilderness? In other words, what does the wild mean to you and how does it play a part in your life or faith?





A prayer for this week:

May we see the wild for all it is. And through that, see ourselves for all we can be.

May we never underestimate the raw power that is held in this wild place. But may we never fear it either.

We give thanks to God who created this place and gladly accept the invitation to step into and embrace the experiences, journeys and lessons that lie before us.

May our feet be ready for the journey. May our minds be thirsty for all that can be learned. And may our hearts be open to the sacred found within the wilderness.

Please hold his wife Val, their children Kimberley and David, his grandchildren, and all the family in your prayers





If anyone can save egg boxes for the craft activities for 4F, please leave them in the glasshouse.


