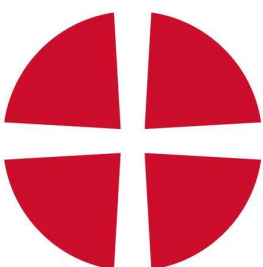

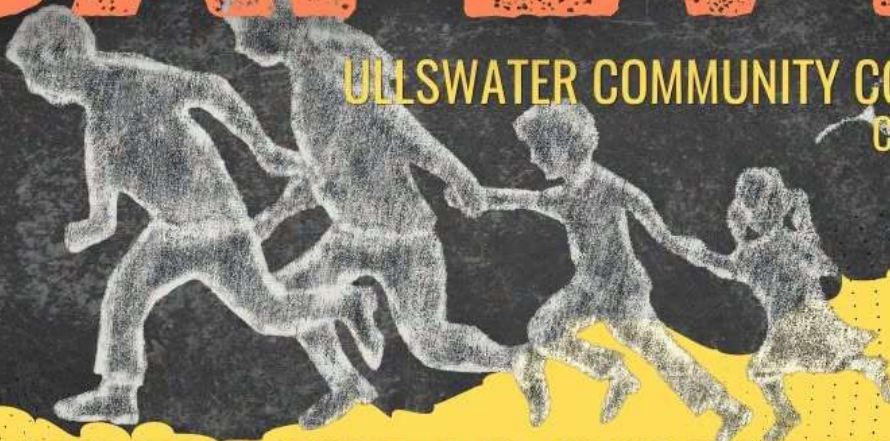
We also need volunteers (could be some of the same people or others) who will help plan the day over the coming weeks.

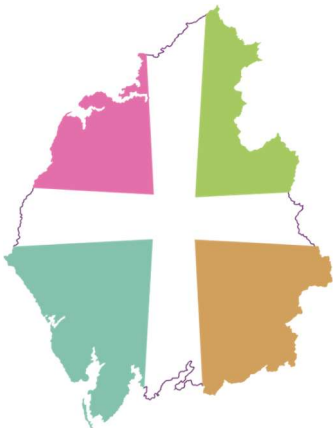
