

Weekly Bulletin Sunday 8th June Pentecost

Come, Holy Spirit

'until the Spirit is poured upon us from on high' Isaiah 32:15 'I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh' Joel 2:28

As Christians we celebrate the moment these and other prophecies came to fruition as described in the remarkable narrative of Acts 2, an event the risen Jesus prepared the disciples for: 'while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about. For John baptized with a water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."' Acts 1:4-5

I trust you know the Pentecost story well and you may also know that Pentecost is a holiday of the Hebrew Scriptures which is still celebrated today by Jewish people - Shavuot.

It is the Feast of Weeks because Shavuot means 'weeks' and it comes from an elapsed period of time to celebrate a second 'first fruit' offering after an earlier offering was made seven weeks prior. (See Leviticus 23.) Pentecost in Koine Greek means 'fiftieth'.

However, at the time of Jesus Pentecost was more than just a time to remember how the land and its fruitfulness was a gift from the Lord. It had also become the anniversary of the giving of the Law to Moses on Mount Sinai and that was why many pilgrims would have been joyfully bringing their offerings to Jerusalem.

In Exodus 19 when God first gave the Law on the mountain there was thunder and lightning and a loud trumpet blast causing the people to tremble. And in Acts 2 we have 'a sound like a mighty rushing wind' and 'tongues of fire'. It's not a coincidence. There's a Jewish tradition which elaborates on the Exodus story recorded in The Targums (paraphrased Aramaic version of portions of the Hebrew bible) which says 'then a flame on the right and a tongue of fire on the left would fly through the air and return and hover over the heads of the Israelites'.

The significance of all of this is that God was indeed present and writing again at Pentecost, but this time 'not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts'. 2 Cor 3:3

The devotional phone app, Lectio 365, has appropriately been quoting a prayer of St. Augustine this week:

> Breathe in me, O Holy Spirit, that my thoughts may be holy. Act in me, O Holy Spirit, that my work may be holy. Draw my heart, O Holy Spirit, to love what is holy.

Come, Holy Spirit, and add to our number 'day by day those who are being saved'. Acts 2:46
