

Weekly Bulletin Sunday 6th July Praise in the Midst of the Storm

Where do you like to praise and worship God?

In church on a Sunday morning? Out in the mountains and lakes that we have right on our doorstep?

Truth is, it's easy to worship God in those places. It's easy to trust in God when the worship band is playing our favourite song, or our favourite hymn rings out on the organ. It's easy to feel the peace of God and have the right intentions when we're stood at the top of a mountain overlooking some incredible views.



The reality is that Churches are often designed to provoke an emotional reaction, to be safe environments where you feel at home. When we're out walking in nature and the serotonin is flowing through our system, it's easy to feel peaceful. These are not bad facts, and they do not negate what God is doing through you at those times. We should all seek those places out more in our busy and hectic lives.

My question is - how do you carry the peace that you feel in those places back into your stressful life? How do we continue to praise God in the places where it is hardest?



In Mark 4 we see Jesus and his disciples caught in a storm. The disciples are scared. They thought they were going to drown. Fearing for their lives, they wake Jesus, but Jesus simply gets up and tells the storm to be quiet. He asks the disciples "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

If we are to feel true peace, if we are to be able to trust God in all aspects of our life, we must focus on God in all aspects of our life. When the kids are screaming and making a mess, that's when we must lift our hands and say, 'I praise you God and I thank you for bringing me to this point'; or when we get stressed about our job, that's when we lift our voice and say, 'not my will God but yours!'.

Let's remember to praise God when we feel it is hardest, and through that we will encounter peace in the times that feel most chaotic.

If you would like to come on the walk, please be at our house at 2pm. After the walk we will return home for drinks and cakes.


If you prefer not to walk, you are very welcome to come to our house any time from about 2 15pm and enjoy a social get-together with refreshments mid-afternoon.

The price is £4.15 per copy for a bulk order.






# Rev. Dave's leaving service

Regular users of our church library will have noticed that a few weeks ago, a group of concerned members had a Saturday morning sort out.


All the tatty books with yellow pages, spines falling off and worse were taken to be recycled.
