

Weekly Bulletin Sunday 20th July Anyone for a game of Yo-Yo?



Giovanni Bellini "Virgin and Child" (c. 1488 – 90) The Burrell Collection, Glasgow https://artuk.org/discover/artworks/virgin-andchild-83176 Although my love of art goes way back to when I was a teenager, my interest in specifically religious art came much later. And, this was probably among the first paintings to make me really explore Christian symbolism in Art.

I first saw this particular painting about 20 years ago, and it intrigued me. What on earth is going on here?

Jesus stands on the ledge of a brown marble balustrade with Mary holding on to him. They play a kind of a game, a bit like yo-yo. There's some sort of twig with darkcoloured flowers that Jesus is dangling on a piece of nearly invisible thread.

I didn't get it! So... I sent an e-mail to the museum to ask what this was all about. They were very helpful, and this was the reply I got: **"The**

sprig held on the end of string by the Christ Child could be myrtle, and may represent the "virga" or shoot from the tree of Jesse (Isaiah 11.1). This could be a punning reference to the Virgin 'sprouting forth' the Virgin child. It may also be a reference to the wood from the crucifix upon which Christ was hung. The faces of the figures, particularly Mary, are solemn and sombre, indicating that they know the fate of Jesus." I had never heard the idea that the wood for the Cross was from a myrtle tree. I can't find many other references either, but Ferguson ("Signs and Symbols in Christian Art") says that myrtle is a sign of love. It's also a reference to Zechariah 1.8 – 11, which mentions myrtle trees and is a vision of "the whole world at rest and in peace..."

Myrtle is an evergreen, so is sometimes also pictured to

symbolise eternal life. "Virga" is Latin for twig, stick or staff, hence "rod of Jesse", but it sounds a bit like "Virgo" which means Virgin. A Virgo with a Virga. A pun! Ho ho... Now I got it. A 500 year old joke.

The way in which Jesus holds the thread makes the gesture of blessing. The viewer comes to the balustrade – a bit like the altar rail – to kneel and worship, and to receive Christ's blessing.

And so... after 13 years here in Penrith and the surrounding area, I come to my final article for the weekly Bulletin. I really hope that some of my passion for Art has rubbed off and that some of you may have caught some of my enthusiasm. 



In spite of hopes and promises, Ukraine still desperately needs our help. Some of the urgent and ongoing needs are:


- Soap
