During our lives we will all insure one or more of the following things: Cars, Properties, Household Contents, Travel, Health, Lives.



Some people may be tempted to think that the way life is lived is an insurance policy. If we live a good life, if we try our best, then we will go to heaven. Some expect that if they have faith in God then that will prevent them from suffering difficult times. The reality is that this is not the case. We do not go to heaven because of what we do but only through God's love and grace and his forgiveness. Christians will experience life's difficulties just like everyone else but have the knowledge of God's helping presence through the Holy Spirit.

So is Christianity an Insurance Policy? Not if we expect our faith to keep us from problems. Just as having policies don't prevent accidents, losses etc but are there to ease the burden, make right what was wrong, so our faith offers us the 'cushion' of God's Love.

Their policies did not just offer Insurance but the Assurance that they would be there for whatever their clients needed. We have that same assurance. In spite of hopes and promises, Ukraine still desperately needs our help. Some of the urgent and ongoing needs are:


- Soap
