Do you remember the event Easter People? Well, I'm afraid I'm going to show my age a little by telling you the event was just about finished by the time I joined the Youth Group at a Methodist Church. But I still remember our Youth Leaders telling us about the event and how it was all about living as "Easter People". That as Christians we ought to be living as people of the resurrection. Living as though Christ is no longer in the grave, but has arisen – Alleluia!

Because if we believe that Christ has risen, that death has been defeated, and that the same power that rose Christ from the grave lives in us, then we should live like that is true every day.

And even though I was only 11/12 at the time, and wouldn't even have called myself a Christian until I was about 14, that message has stuck with me, from an event I never attended!

I don't know about you, but this year has felt particularly dark. Just watching the news and all the stories of war, and politics, and the environment, and the rich getting richer and the poor getting poorer, and, and, and... Just fills me with all sorts of despair and anger and futility. By September, when the nights were just starting to get darker, and the days getting colder, I was already thinking, "I can't wait for it to be Christmas." Because for me, Christmas has always been a time of joy, even before I was a Christian, as a Child, Christmas brought joy and wonder. And this year, that joy couldn't come soon enough.



Think of a Child on Christmas day and all that excitement. Even think back to the first Christmas and the message the Angels brought to the Shepherds, "*Do not be afraid; for see—I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: ¹¹ to you*

is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, who is the Messiah,^[a] the Lord.” (Luke 2:10-11)

Or perhaps the joy of a mother holding her newborn baby. I know the song ‘*Mary did you know*’, has me thinking “Yes of course she did, the Angel Gabriel already told her that” to some of the lines, but the line, “And when you kiss your little baby, you’ve kissed the face of God” always strikes me. I’m not sure I could possibly imagine all the feelings that Mary was feeling.

So, as we light our candle for joy this Sunday, perhaps for a time, we can stop being “Easter People,” for just a time, and become “Christmas People”. A people living with the joy of a Saviour, walking and living amongst us, God with us, Emmanuel.




